PCS Board Operating Principles

COMMUNICATION

- *Maintain open communication with each other, the administration and the general public such that there are no surprises for the Board or Superintendent.*
- *Make decisions on information and not on personalities with the expectation that all members will receive the same information in a timely manner.*
- *Coordinate all requests for information (RFI) or records through the Superintendent. Only the Board itself may authorize the Superintendent or her staff to engage in research projects or the compilation of records or data in response to a RFI that are estimated to require more than three hours of staff time.*
- *Attend meetings well prepared to discuss all matters on the agenda and strive for efficient decision-making.*
- *Debate the issues and not one another. Engage in critical thinking expecting all members to freely voice differing views.*
- *Once a decision is reached, recognize the "official" voice of the Board.*

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Objective 6

Pueblo City Schools will secure and utilize 100% of human, financial, and physical resources required to create and sustain world-class public schools and this strategic plan.

Targeted Goal

Develop and implement procedures to evaluate new and existing initiatives and to establish appropriate funding sources.
