

Regular Board Meetings

All members of the Board of Education are expected to attend in person all regular and special meetings of the Board of Education during their respective terms of office. However, circumstances may arise intermittently which may prevent such personal attendance on the part of one or more Board members. In such cases, Board members are encouraged to attend such meetings by telephone whenever possible, so long as a speaker phone is in place at the meeting and working in such a manner as to allow all Board members and all members of the public attending such meeting to hear and understand all Board members and all members of the public when speaking, and a full and complete discussion is allowed to occur prior to the members of the Board of Education actually voting on the individual matters on the Board agenda.

Additionally, Board members shall provide timely notice to the Board secretary if they are unable to attend a meeting or if they will arrive after the scheduled start of a meeting.
