

Use of Video Surveillance

The Board of Education recognizes the District's continuing responsibility to maintain and improve discipline and to promote the health, welfare, and safety of its staff and students in and around District facilities and on District property. These objectives are best implemented with a multifaceted approach. To the extent modern electronic technologies assist in providing another tool to maintain a safe and secure environment, the use of electronic technologies such as video surveillance cameras is supported by the Board of Education.

The District shall comply with all applicable state and federal laws related to the use of video surveillance and as related to storing and maintaining video recordings.

The superintendent or his/her designee is directed to develop regulations governing the use of video surveillance in accordance with applicable federal and state law and Board policies and regulations.
