

Video Cameras on Transportation Vehicles

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of maintaining and improving student discipline to ensure the health, welfare and safety of its staff and students on school transportation vehicles. Accordingly, the Board supports the use of video cameras on its transportation vehicles to monitor student behavior.

Students in violation of bus conduct rules or other Board policy shall be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with Board policy and regulations governing student conduct and discipline.

The district shall comply with applicable law related to maintaining video recordings.

Video surveillance shall be used only to promote the order, safety and security of students, staff and property.

The deputy superintendent is directed to develop regulations governing the use of video cameras on transportation vehicles in accordance with applicable law and Board policies and regulations.
