

Copyright Compliance

The Board shall conform to United States copyright and intellectual property laws in all areas (i.e. print, computer software, audiovisual materials, music, etc.) as they may be amended from time to time and shall maintain proper ethical standards for use of copyrighted materials for instructional purposes. All district employees shall be expected to adhere to the provisions of law, rules and regulations concerning the use of copyright materials.

Employees who violate copyright laws shall not be protected by the district's insurance.

Each building administrator shall be responsible for establishing practices which will enforce this policy at that building site.
